Our watchman give Him no rest till He establishes & makes Jerusalem (Yakima) a praise in the earth. Is. 62:7

WE PRAISE GOD FOR HIS FAITHFULNESS: Ps 24:7-10 Who is this King of glory? The Lord strong and mighty, The Lord mighty in battle. ⁹Lift up your heads, O you gates! Lift up, you everlasting doors! And the King of glory shall come in. ¹⁰Who is this King of glory? The Lord of hosts, He is the King of glory. *Selah*

WE ARE EAGER FOR REMOVAL OF THE BURDEN OF SIN : Matt 11:28 Come to Me, all *you* who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. **Is 55:6-7** Seek the Lord while He may be found, call upon Him while He is near. Let the wicked forsake his way, And the unrighteous man his thoughts; Let him return to the Lord, and He will have mercy on him; and to our God, For He will abundantly pardon.

WE PRAISE GOD FOR HIS INVITATION: Matt 11:28 Come to Me, all *you* who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. **Rev 22:17** And the Spirit and the bride say, “Come!” And let him who hears say, “Come!” And let him who thirsts come. Whoever desires, let him take the water of life freely. **John 7:37** On the last day, that great *day* of the feast, Jesus stood and cried out, saying, “If anyone thirsts, let him come to Me and drink.

WE PRAISE GOD FOR HIS PROMISE OF POWER: Acts 1:8 But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.” **1 Thes 1:5** For our gospel did not come to you in word only, but also in power, and in the Holy Spirit and in much assurance, as you know what kind of men we were among you for your sake.

OUR RESPONSE: Matt 24:12 We pray for the reduction and eradication of domestic violence, fatherlessness and homelessness, mass shootings increase “as the love of many has grown cold.” **Ps 143:8** Cause me to hear Your lovingkindness in the morning, for in You do I trust; Cause me to know the way in which I should walk, for I lift up my soul to You. **Mark 12:29** Jesus answered him, “The first of all the commandments is: ‘Hear, O Israel, the Lord our God, the Lord is one. **Luke 10:27** So he answered and said, ‘You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your strength, and with all your mind,’ and ‘your neighbor as yourself.’ **1 Cor 15:58** Therefore, my beloved brethren, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that your labor is not in vain in the Lord. **Col 4:2** Continue earnestly in prayer, being vigilant in it with thanksgiving.

OUR UNITED PRAYER: We pray, Our Father in heaven, who is the Father of all, we pray that You would send us Your Spirit to strengthen us as Your children so that Christ may dwell in our hearts through faith. We pray that we might be rooted and established in love, and that we may have power, together with all Your people to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ. And to know this love that surpasses knowledge – so that we may be filled to the measure of all Your fullness. Above all, we pray that we would love each other deeply, because love covers over a multitude of sins. Help us to get rid of all bitterness, anger and evil speaking. Help us to be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as for Christ’s sake You have forgiven us. Let us love our neighbors as ourselves. Let husbands love their wives as Christ loved the Church and wives love and respect their husbands. Help us to bear one another’s burdens and become knit together in love so that the world will know that You sent Jesus as a demonstration of Your love for us. Let the peace of Christ fill our hearts and our Valley for Your glory. Amen (December 2016)
